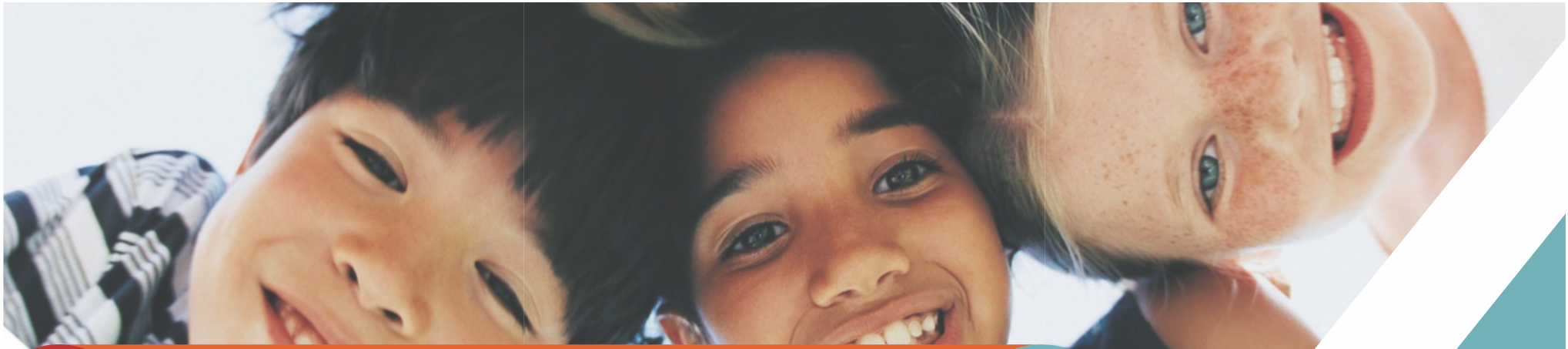

Alta Vista Children's Shelter



Opened in 1999 to meet the needs of a younger population, Alta Vista Children's Shelter is the only shelter in the state licensed to accept children as young as six. Alta Vista Children's Shelter is a 10 bed facility that includes an industrial playground, visitation room, family style dining, entrainment, stations, reading room, access to a full sized gym, age appropriate play areas and outdoor recreation space.
